LESSON 19

JESUS' FIRST MIRACLE

John 2:1-11

Jesus, his mother and disciples (the friends of Jesus) were invited to a wedding. During the wedding feast, there was no wine left to drink. Mary told Jesus what had happened, and then told the servants to do whatever Jesus asked them.

Jesus asked the servants to fill six large jars with water. When they poured this out and took it to the ruler of the feast, the water had turned into wine. Usually, people served the best wine first at a wedding, but this time, the wine they had last was the best.

Jesus had used God's power to help his friends. This was called a miracle.

ACTIVITY

Sprinkle the upright jars with sand, glitter, or decorate with patterns using confetti, stars, sequins, etc. Cover the pouring jar with red cellophane and use red glitter to indicate the wine pouring out.

FURTHER SUGGESTIONS

Make pots out of clay or plasticine.

Cut out six water pots from fanfolded paper, so that they are joined by the handles when opened out. Write the numbers 1 to 6 on the pots.
